Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition for professional programs is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses including CU Boulder Online and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. The Student Activity Fee and the Rec Center Expansion Fee combined make up CUSG fees (colorado.edu/cusg). Students paying full fees are members of the Rec Center. Students who pay partial or base fees can purchase a Rec Center membership (colorado.edu/recreation/facilities/membership-and-lockers/membership-rates#student) that makes up the difference between the partial and full fee amounts.

2025–26 Mandatory Student Fee Changes

The following changes to fees will be in effect starting in Fall 2025; student services will remain the same:

- The A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee \$1.32 per credit hour will be eliminated for all student starting in Fall 2025.
- The following fees will be converted to tuition starting in Fall 2025 and will no longer be assessed individually. Student services will remain the same: Arts & Cultural Enrichment Fee, Career Services Fee,³ Mental Health Resource Fee, Student Computing Fee, Student Health Fee, Transit Pass Fee.

Student Health Insurance (tentative rates)

Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) \$2,442

BuffCare Supplement \$270

All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder. Students must meet this requirement their first semester at CU Boulder and at the beginning of each academic year. Graduate students enrolled in one or more credit hours are required to complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline in order to avoid automatic enrollment in the SHIP along with a charge on the tuition bill. New Student Fee

One-time nonrefundable fee for new graduate students and transfers upon entering a degree program \$62

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.
- Students can sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.
